Fels Data Spotlight: STAR Assessments

Our students recently completed their Winter STAR assessments in Reading and Math. These tests provide a "snapshot" of student growth and help our teachers tailor instruction to your child's specific needs.

The Big Win	
Reading	<p>🟡 23% of students scored At/Above Benchmark (highest tier) schoolwide during Winter Window in comparison to 19% during Fall Window</p> <p>🟡 54.2% of students scored Intensive Intervention (lowest tier) during Winter Window in comparison to 57.5% during Fall Window</p>
Math	<p>🟡 26.8% of students scored At/Above Benchmark (highest tier) schoolwide during Winter Window in comparison to 19.2% during Fall Window</p> <p>🟡 45.7% of students scored Intensive Intervention (lowest tier) during Winter Window in comparison to 47.5% during Fall Window</p>
